GWD update: South Valley GWD has been approved by CC Commissioners – Nov Ballot Galena GWD first meeting. Very eclectic group.

SVGWD: 125 users, 80% irrigate more than 20 acres for a total of 516 cfs Galena GWD: 380 users, with < 240 cfs for 31% of total cfs in the valley . Multitude of uses

Important: you can and should support the formation of GWD and opt out without any problems. We need all people to support GWD formation, even if you are doing private mitigation, so that others have options for collaborative mitigation.
